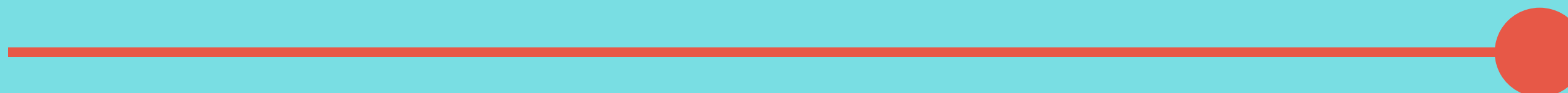

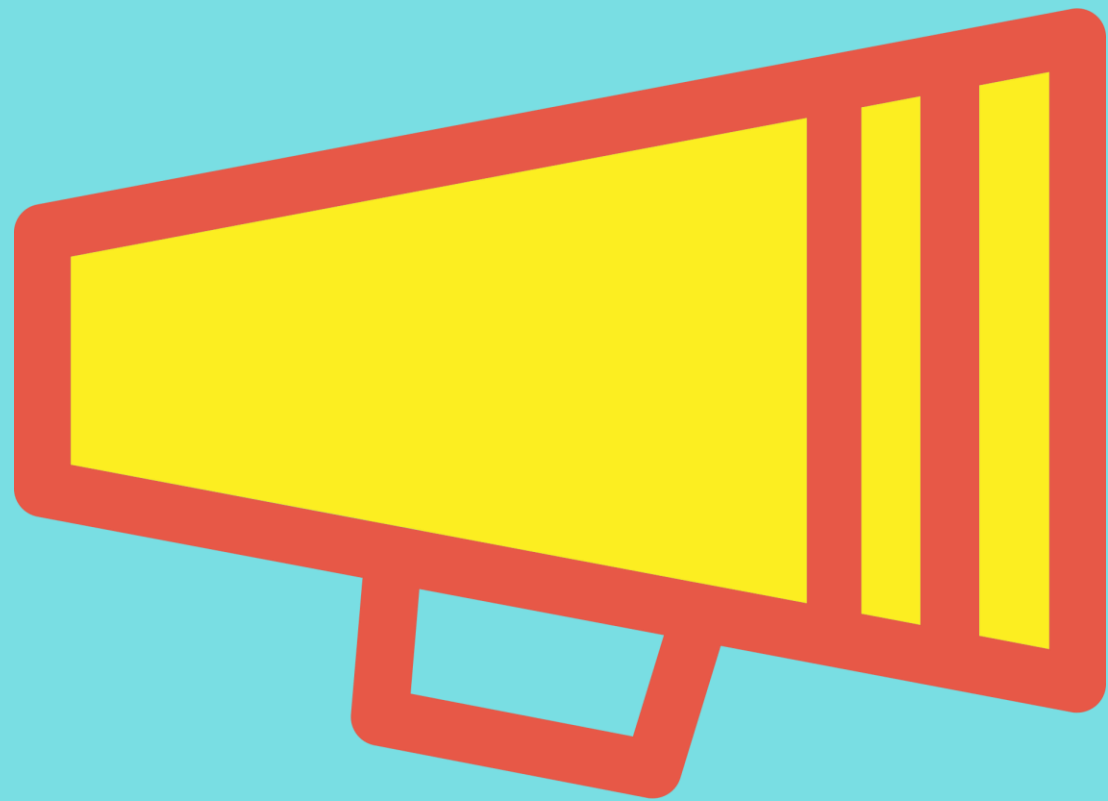

- **360cities.net – allows you to “walk” through cities panning the screen in different directions.**

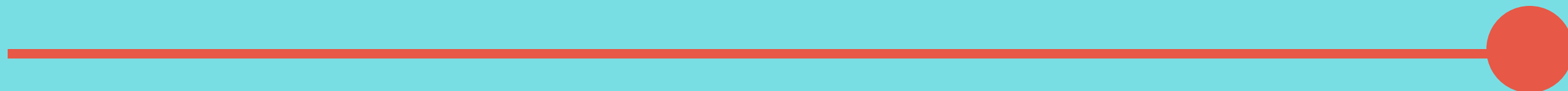
What does it look like?



Virtually visit 3 of the national parks.

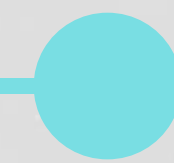
Prepare a Visitor Guide:

Answer the following:

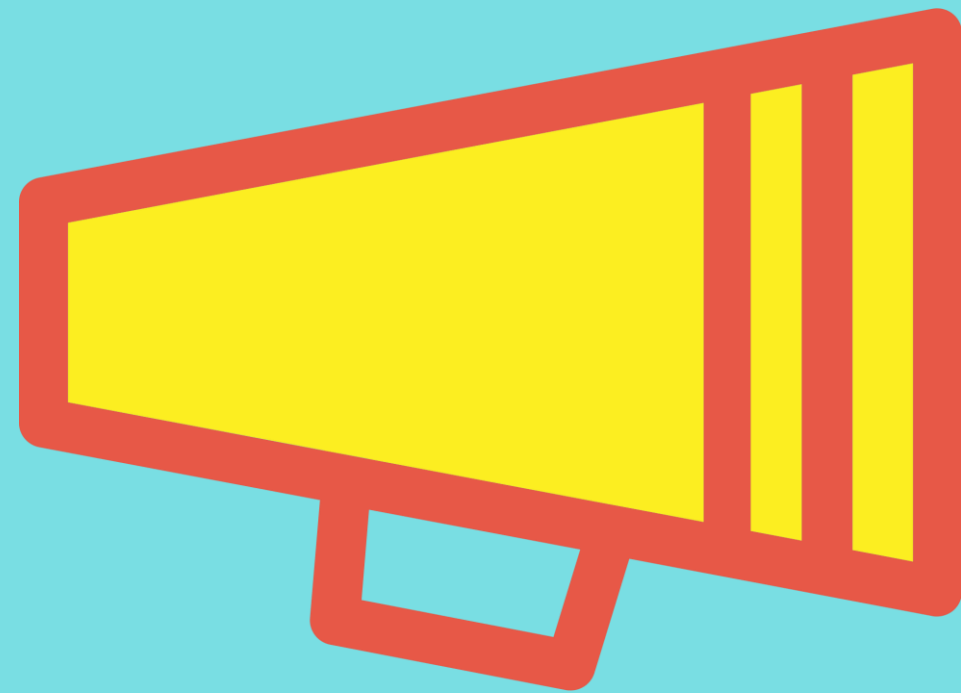
What is the topic? (provide screenshots)

Here is a [helpful guide](#) on how to find key messages in content.

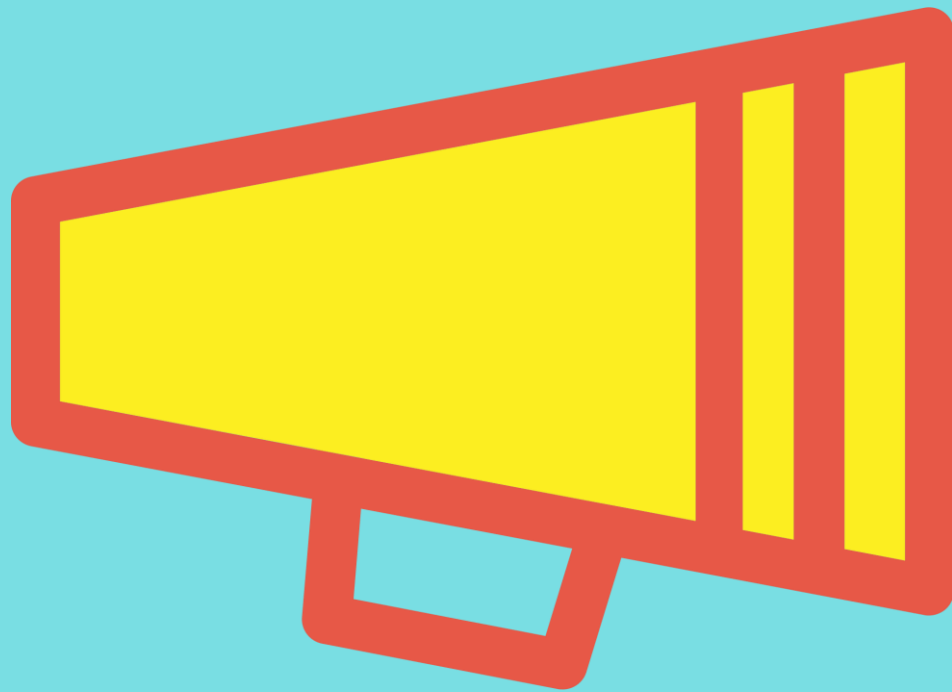


****Other activities would be to ask students to use Zoom, Google, or other telecommunicating software to virtually interview someone from a different country.***

- **Powerpoint lectures can have voice overs or video, and then be exported into an MP4 format**
- **Hold synchronous online sessions**
- **Consider “housing” the course content on a free platform site such as a free Canvas page not affiliated with your instructor credentials**
- **Set initial expectations regarding the respect of other people from other cultures, with “what to do” and “what not to do” for each of the learning activities**

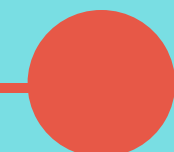
